# 65<sup>TH</sup> GENOA INTERNATIONAL BOAT SHOW: INNOVATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

Preparations are already underway for the 65th Genoa International Boat Show, organised by the Italian Marine Industry Association's operating subsidiary I Saloni Nautici, an event that this year is set to welcome exhibitors and visitors from across the globe to its purpose-designed state-of-the-art exhibition venue. The event, open from 18th to 23rd September 2025, will take place across a surface area of over 220,000 square metres, 80% of which is outdoors, hosting more than 1,000 boats and providing visitors with opportunity to try out boats directly on the sea during the six days of the Boat Show.

The 2025 edition is conceived, designed and organised in full adherence to the ISO 20121 Certification principles. Issued by the certifying body RINA to I Saloni Nautici in December 2024, the certification acknowledges the Genoa International Boat Show's commitment to sustainable event planning and management, reflecting strategies oriented towards reducing environmental impact and promoting responsible practices, while also focusing on ethical values such as accessibility and social inclusion, thus consolidating the Genoa International Boat Show as a leading example of organisation, management and sustainability across the sector.

The 2025 Genoa International Boat Show will once again follow its tried and tested multi-specialist format, featuring renewed services tailored to the five market segments that embody a constantly evolving industry:


Italy's contribution to global superyacht order trends from 2016 to 2025



Sample analysis, fixed base value for 2010 = 100




# Top 5 Italian export markets in the boatbuilding sector

2023, percentage of Italy's export markets worldwide




## Italian export of recreational and sport boats

12-month rolling period; in millions of euros; updated as of June 2024











